This three-day course outlines the OSHA requirements for the establishment, maintenance and monitoring of a respiratory protection program. Respirator selection, cleaning, maintenance and storage are discussed, and qualitative and quantitative fit-testing are demonstrated. The general requirements for the OSHA 1910.134 Revised Respiratory Protection Standard are also explained.

The Code of Federal Regulations, Title 49, Subpart H, requires training for persons involved in the handling of hazardous materials that are transported in commerce. These training requirements mandate initial training for new hazardous materials employees within 90 days of employment. Recurrent training is required at least once every three years.
