Excavation and Trenching: Competent Person Training

If you or your employees engage in trenching activities, you may be the target of increased scrutiny by OSHA, safety inspectors and insurance carriers. This course is designed to give you a practical interpretation of the OSHA requirements for "Competent Person" rules as well as other regulations related to trenching. You learn the essentials of soil analysis, protective systems, and the applicable OSHA standards.
