This four day class is designed to help the Class A examinee study for and pass the management section of the Florida Class A Wastewater exam. Topics covered on day four include management theories, types of supervision, functions of management, motivating, evaluating and disciplining employees. Days 1-3 covers material with the folks in the Wastewater Class B Certification Review course (see below). Day 4 will be an additional day of management material review.
