Wastewater Class A Certification Review

April 17-20, 2012

Cost: \$560

Times: Day 1: 8:00am- 4:30pm | Day 2 & 3: 8:00am- 4:00pm
Day 4: 8:00am-12:00pm

This three-and-one-half day class is designed to help the Class A examinee study for and pass the management section of the Florida Class A Wastewater exam. Topics covered on day four include management theories, types of supervision, functions of management, motivating, evaluating and disciplining employees. Days 1-3 covers material with the folks in the Wastewater Class B Certification Review course (see below). Day 4 will be an additional 1/2 day of management material review.

Wastewater Class B Certification Review

April 17-19, 2012

Three full days of intense exam review and preparation. Material covered includes: anaerobic digestion and troubleshooting, advanced wastewater math, filtration, nitrogen and phosphorus removal, disinfection and disinfection troubleshooting, activated sludge processes and troubleshooting and FDEP regulations.

Wastewater Class C Certification Review

March 20-23, 2012

Times: Days 1-3: 8:00am-4:30pm | Day 4:8:00am-12:pm

This is a three and a half-day event that covers subjects an operator needs to know when studying for the Florida Class C wastewater exam. Topics include: Safety, activated sludge processes and troubleshooting, disinfection, wastewater math, FDEP rules, sludge digestion and effluent disposal.
