Description

This three day course offers advanced training that will prepare the participant to meet the expanded duties of a Level 1 operator and/or manager as well as aid the student in applying for and taking Florida's Level 1 Water Distribution Operators Exam. Students must have their level 2 & 3 Water Distribution license before taking this course.

Upon successful course completion, students receive course certificates that can be used to apply for the state of Florida Level 1 Distribution System Operators exam.

Course Objectives

At the conclusion of the course, the participant will:

1. Discuss the operation, maintenance and management needs of a water distribution system serving 100,000 or more persons
2. Interpret Federal, State and Local rules and regulations
3. Identify the water quality concerns and disinfection needs of water distribution systems
4. Describe the safety practices and programs related to water distribution system operation and maintenance
5. Discuss the administrative requirements of water distribution system management
6. identify the supervisory skills required of water distribution system managers
7. Demonstrate the ability to perform math calculations related to the operation, maintenance and management of a water distribution system
8. Demonstrate the ability to take computer based tests
